

## OCTOBER 16, 2007

The regular monthly meeting of the Hiles Town Board held on Tuesday, October 16, 2007, was called to order at 7 p.m. Present were supervisors Doris Lovrine and Larry Berg. Chairman Marilyn Pfeiffer and clerk Cathy Votis. Treasurer Judy McKay-Burkey was absent. Agenda was read as posted. Motion to accept Lovrine. Second Berg. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Minutes of the September meeting were read. Motion to accept Berg. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. There was no treasurer's report. OFFICER & COMMITTEE REPORTS: Clerk presented the board with the contract from B.A. Pauls for the 2008-2009 assessment maintenance for the same costs as last time of \$9,400.00. A motion was made by Berg to accept this contract from B.A. Pauls for the 2008-2009 assessment maintenance for \$9,400.00. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Berg reported that he attended the TRIPP meeting (Marilyn was unable to) and stated that it was voted on to split the money between the towns. He also nominated Marilyn to be on the TRIPP committee and she was voted in. He also asked that the playground project be considered to be put in the budget for next year. Lovrine brought up concerns again about whether or not the Four Duck Lake Road is a town road or not. There seems to be a lot of differing information and Pfeiffer said that the board needs to look into this more. She will try to contact the towns attorney and get his opinion. Board could perhaps have enough information to discuss this at the December regular board meeting. Pfeiffer reported that she did attend the next meeting of the TRIPP committee and apply for \$31,000.00 for 2 ½ miles of the Fournier Road to be double chip sealed. This would be more economical and the TRIPP program will now accept double chip seal now. They did not in the past. She also stated that this will be done even if the town does not receive the TRIPP grant. She also stated that at this time all the street lights seem to be now working. Also, the road crew swept Old Hwy 32 and it is shaping up very well. Board has no further business. CITIZENS INPUT: Gary Urban stated that he had come to thank the board for taking care of Old Hwy 32. Crew did a good job. And for reporting the street lights. VOUCHERS: A motion was made by Berg to approve for payment vouchers #135657-13578. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Motion to adjourn Berg. Second Pfeiffer. Vote all aye. Meeting adjourned at 8:25 p.m.
