

## **JULY 21, 2009**

The regular monthly meeting of the Hiles Town Board called to order at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, July 21, 2009 by Chairman Pfeiffer. Present: Lovrine, Berg Supervisors, clerk Votis and Treasurer McKay-Burkey. Agenda read. Motion to accept Berg. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Minutes read. Motion to accept Lovrine. Second Berg. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Treasurer gave report. BARTENDERS LICENSE APPLICATION: from Katie Ison. For regular license Responsible Beverage course proof provided. Linda Ludin for a provisional. Motion by Berg to grant these licenses. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. OFFICER & COMMITTEE REPORTS: Berg stated that concerned taxpayer called him about a dangerous tree on Circle Drive. Will have crew look at it. He also stated that he has had concerns about the complaints about changing the transfer station hours. Feels that the only day hours have been changed is Saturday and that a couple of months need to go by to see how this works. Lovrine also had concern about a tree hanging over on Kentuck Lake Rd. Will look into this. Had complaint that someone dumped garbage at the north end transfer station and is not a resident of the town. Paul will start to check better. Also complaint about why the town is going to black top part of a road that is in the town of Phelps. Board feels it will benefit the town by making it safer for the road crew to turn around at. Pfeiffer reported that the comprehensive plan committee is going well and will hold a public hearing very soon. The next meeting will be on August 8<sup>th</sup>. She met with the Forest Service on July 16, 2009 concerning the Woodbury Lake Rd. and problem with people from Teaching Drum School in the way for the town grader. Forest Service was very supportive of the town. She also expressed concern on how the walking trail on the Experimental Road is over grown along with the building they have that is not used. Road construction projects for this year were discussed and bids will be let. A proposal from Forest County Highway Dept was presented to the board for work to be done on Herman Lane and Atkins Road for \$65,172.80. Motion was made by Berg to accept this bid. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. The road crew has said that they feel they can cut down the hill on the Fournier road. Lastly, there will be a joint effort with the DNR, Pine Lake District and the town to redo the Pine Lake boat landing. Work should begin in September. CITIZENS INPUT: Lois Tucker had concerns on the change in hours for Saturdays. Had a count of people during the new hours and that she had 212 signatures opposed to the change. Board stated that it has only been two Saturdays and it looked to them like some people are taking advantage of the earlier hours and will continue with these hours for the summer at least. Tom Knause said they need a bathroom at the transfer station. Board said they have been working on getting one. Chuck Hill updated that board on the situation at Station B fire dept. Seems he is only around 6 month out of the year and no one wants to be acting chief when he is not there. Also members are getting older and new membership seems to be at a stand still. Seems no one wants to invest in the time to get training. This was discussed and will be monitored. Dave Houle told that Winchester Ln sign is missing. Clerk stated that it has been ordered. Tom Knause asked how much money was set aside for the Pine Lake Dam. Discussed. Dennis Schumacher asked if a speed limit of 10 MPH could be place on the road around the lake for ATV'S. Board stated that it is a state law that they must go 10MPH when approaching private driveways. Discussed. No further input. VOUCHERS: Motion by Berg to approve for payment vouchers #14521-14558. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Motion to adjourn Pfeiffer. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Meeting adjourned at 8:47 p.m.

The hour of 8 p.m. has arrived and Board of Review has met for the statutory 2 hours and no one has appeared before Board of Review so a motion to adjourn the 2009 Board of Review is in order.
