

AUGUST 18, 2009

The regular monthly meeting of the Hiles Town board was called to order at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, August 18, 2009. Present: Chairman Pfeiffer, Supervisors Lovrine and Berg. Clerk Votis and Treasurer McKay-Burkey. Agenda read. Moved to approve Berg. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Minutes read. Motion to approve Lovrine. Second Berg. Vote all aye. Motion carried. There was no treasurer's report. BIDS: There was only one bid receive for the Tuttle Road Project from Fahrner Asphalt for \$29,169.36 along with certificate of insurance. After short discussion, Berg moved to accept this bid. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. CRACK SEAL PROPOSAL: this was also receive from Fahrner Asphalt to not exceed \$15,000.00 for crack sealing on various town roads. Motion by Berg to accept this proposal. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. OFFICER & COMMITTEE REPORTS: Lovrine stated she had a request from Glen Moder asking if the town could have the crew remove some trees along Young's Lane by the first corner off of Butternut Lake Road. Seems they visibility to see bikers or walkers is poor. She also mentioned if it was town policy to allow businesses to take their garbage to the transfer station. Seems Camp Nicolet generates a lot. Town does not require businesses to have their own dumpsters. Pfeiffer has several items 1) She has received a lot of census forms to fill out. 2)the work on Atkins and Herman's lane should be done within the next 2 weeks. 3) The Pine River Road will be closed for six weeks while work is being done on the bridge should be late September. 4) Comprehensive committee will meet on Wed. August 26th at 4 p.m. and this should be the last meeting before a public hearing will be held. 5) She has contacted and met with Urban Steel concerning the remodel of the town hall entrance. They have some really good ideas and will be drawing up plans and hopefully we will have these for the September meeting. BARTENDERS LICENSE: A renewal was presented to the board from Anissa Widule. Motion to grant by Berg. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion granted. A copy of a letter sent to Lois Tucker from Pam Labine concerning who Lois works for was read by the clerk. Clerk also informed the board that she has received a letter concerning a burial site in the north end of the town. Seems historical society is interested in this also. Pfeiffer took the information and will look into this. Clerk asked for a motion from the board to purchase 8 six yard dumpsters from Wastequip. Pfeiffer moved to purchase these dumpsters. Second Berg. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Treasurer stated that she has renewed the Dam CD. CITIZENS INPUT: Richard Votis told the board that the posts at the end of Sucker Creek Road are gone along with the dead end road sign. The stop sign on here going on th Mitchell Platt Rd is covered in brush. He also asked why the dam was closed and the lake is 3" high and who regulates the Millpond Dam. VOUCHERS: Motion made by Lovrine to approve for payment vouchers # 14559 - 14596. Second Berg. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Motion to adjourn Lovrine. Second Berg. Vote all aye.
