The regular monthly meeting of the Hiles Town Board came to order at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, September 15, 2009 at the Hiles Town Office. Present were: Lovrine & Berg, supervisors; Pfeiffer, chairman; Votis, clerk and McKay-Burkey, Treasurer. Agenda read as posted. Motion to accept Lovrine. Second Berg. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Minutes: motion to make change from saying Camp Nicolet to some businesses - with this amendment made by Berg. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Treasurer gave report. **BARTENDERS LICENSE:** Applications were presented from Timothy Horn & Linda Ludin. Everything is in order. Motion by Berg to grant these licenses. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. **OFFICER & COMMITTEE REPORTS:** Lovrine stated that Ann Gruenwald wrote a letter on concerns she has with the tent shelter station B and the possible replacement building. She also told that Tom Carlstedt will take fire training and Paul Gerhart and Glenn Moder are willing to learn to drive the fire trucks. Berg reported on the progress of the Comprehensive Plan Commission. He will also keep eye on problem tree on Circle Drive. Pfeiffer also received letters of concern about a replacement building for the tent on Baker Lane. This is not something that the town is doing at this time. She also said that the welcome sign need sprucing up and the service club will look into this. Urban Steel had not gotten back to her concerning the remodel of the town hall entrance. Will try to talk to them. She did ask if perhaps a notice could be put in the paper or something else done to get property owners to take care of their lawns and junk let out in the open. Clerk stated that the dumpsters were ordered and delivered. Also asked that the passer rating get done. Treasurer stated that people in town are really concerned about the ATV traffic on the Pine Lake Road. Board stated that maybe some poster could be put up telling that they need to go 10MPH. These could be printed by Pioneer Printing. **CITIZENS INPUT:** Mr. Sampon asked why the white toilet paper was on the roads. This is done when crack seal is done to keep the asphalt from getting all over. **VOUCHERS:** Motion by Lovrine to approve for payment vouchers #14597-14639. Second Berg. Vote all aye.
