Pfeiffer stated that Urban Construction still has to finish the hall entrance. The towns crew will also help. Annual roads inspections has been done. The refrigerator in the hall broke down and Tri Co heating has fixed it. Clerk presented the board with the towns annual renewal of insurance from Rural Ins. A motion was made by Berg to renew our policies with Rural Ins. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. **CITIZENS INPUT:** One citizen complimented the comprehensive committee on the great job on the plan. At this time board member Doris Lovrine went and sat where the audience sits and proceeded to read some notes commenting on the letter from the towns attorney Steve Garbowicz concerning the Four Duck Lake Road issue.
