

JUNE 15, 2010

The regular monthly meeting of the Hiles Town Board was called to order at 7:05 p.m. Present: Lovrine, Berg, Pfeiffer, clerk Votis and treasurer McKay-Burkey. Motion to accept agenda as read Lovrine. Second Berg. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Minutes of the May meeting were read. Lovrine asked to amend the minutes to change the word letter to notes where she is addressing the board. With this change motion was made by Pfeiffer to approve. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Treasurer gave report. **FOUR DUCK LAKE ROAD** appearance by Atty Kevin Kelley representing property owners on Four Duck Lake Rd also known as Peninsula Lane and Camp Road in the past. Note that the towns atty Steve Garbowicz was also present. Kelley addressed the board with concerns that the town has maintained this road in years past. He had some of the property owners present and they read notarized statements to the fact that the town has done maintenance on this road for many years in the past. He also stated that the resolution that was done in 1999 by a previous board does not hold any bearing on this. He is petitioning the town board to vote and put this road on the gas tax map as he feels it has been shown the town has maintained it. The towns atty Steve Garbowicz stated that he needs time to look over all this information presented and then advise the board to come to a decision on this to hopefully settle this matter once and for all. **LIQUOR APPLICATIONS: Renewals:** Class A combination from James Draeger for Hiles Outpost. Motion by Berg to grant this license. Second Pfeiffer. Vote all aye. License granted. Class BB combination from Annette Porter for Butternut Lake Lodge and Paul Jenkins for Pine Lake Pub and Café. Motion to grant Pfeiffer. Second Berg. Vote all aye Licenses granted. Only one cigarette license renewal was receive from James Draeger Hiles Outpost. Motion to grant Lovrine. Second Berg. Vote all aye. License granted. **BARTENDERS:** Renewal: Anita Kevilus, Danielle Jeseski, Marilyn Pfeiffer and Cathy Votis New: Margaret Caffey and Stephanie Denton both have shown proof of responsible beverage course. Motion to grant Berg. Second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Licenses granted. **O&C REPORTS:** Pfeiffer received letter from Tamrack Song concerning the development of a Scenic Byway on Hwy 32. Would like to meet with the board informally. He also sent info on how to mow along the road sides. She will contact him on these. A letter was also received from the DNR regarding dam inspections telling on a change in the time frame on this and that an engineer is required to do these inspections. It was also stated that she hired Billy Bochte to do part time mowing in the town. He will receive the same hourly wage as the transfer site custodians. Lovrine stated that some trees on Youngs Lane need to be cut down. They will have red ribbons on them and the town crew will take care of this. Also had concern on some fire numbers not installed or incorrect. They are not done yet and will take a little time to finish and the correct any errors or omissions. **CITIZENS INPUT:** Mr Sampon stated that he felt the new fire numbers were very nice as did Chuck Hill. Hill also addressed the board with information on the need for new pagers for the fire departments. An application to FEMA for a grant for this has been applied for, but if they do not get this grant the town would need to budget \$20,000.00 for this next year. He also asked that the board send Pitlik & Wick a copy of any bid notices for work to be done on the Haymeadow Road and also the Fournier Road as they do not get the Forest Republican. **VOUCHERS:** Motion by Lovrine to approve for payment vouchers #15006-15083. Second Pfeiffer. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Motion to adjourn Lovrine. Second Pfeiffer. Vote all aye. Meeting adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
