TOWN OF HILES EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN: Berg presented the board with a final draft of this plan for the boards approval. Board would do this, but he needs to have the proper documents drawn up at his expense, not the towns. She also would like to receive the agenda sooner. Pfeiffer stated that she is still working on getting an opinion from the WTA on the Zager survey issue. Pfeiffer also stated that the town received a JOINT POWERS OF AGREEMENT from Forest County for the town to sign. She then moved to do so. Second Berg. Vote all aye. Motion carried. The town has also received an invitation to learn about the 2010 census.

BARTENDERS LICENSE: Clerk presented an application from Nancy Tauer for a bartenders license. All requirements have been met. Motion by Pfeiffer to grant this license. Second Berg. Vote all aye. Motion carried. **CITIZENS INPUT:** Mr. Sampon suggest the board inform the public of the Emergency Response plan.
