

**ANNUAL TOWN MEETING
APRIL 8, 2008**

The Annual Town Meeting of the Town of Hiles was called to order on Tuesday, April 8, 2008, at 6:10 p.m by Chairman Marilyn Pfeiffer. Other members of the board present were, Doris Lovrine and Larry Berg; along with clerk Cathy Votis.. There were four (4) citizens in attendance. The 2007 Financial report was available for everyone to review. There were no questions on the report. Mr. Sampon moved that the 2007 financial report be accepted. Second by Amy Houle-Bukovic. Vote was all ayes . None nay. Motion carried. Pfeiffer asked if anyone had any concerns that they would like to bring forth at this time. (1) Mr. Sampon asked if the board had gotten any feedback on not plowing private driveways. Board said that there very few negative concerns and that most people felt that they got quicker service having it done by private services. It was also mentioned that many of the private service providers were very happy about getting the income. Seems it was a good decision. It was asked that more of the private service providers be included in the newsletter in this years tax bills. (2) Amy Houle-Bukovic addressed the meeting and gave an update on where the playground committee know now as "Funds for Fun" is at. She stated that they have raised \$1000.00 doing bake sales and a brat fry. They are also trying to get grant money and working with Forest County Potawatomi. This project is also on the towns web site with hopes that people will see this and donate. They would like to get the steps done this spring if possible. She did ask if money was available from the towns budget. The clerk stated that \$500.00 was put in the budget for this and that any landscaping projects could possibly come out of the General Building Fund. (3) Ruth Frauenfelder thanked the board for applying for a grant from the Forest County Potawatomi for a building were the tent is to house one of the fire trucks for Station B on Kentuck Lake Road. Hopefully the town will get this. There were no other issues. Mr. Sampon moved to adjourn. Second Vic Burkey. Vote was all aye. None nay. Meeting adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
