The regular monthly meeting of the Hiles Town Board was called to order at 7 p.m. Present: Lovrine, Bukovic, Tauer, clerk/treasurer Votis and deputy Micolichuk. Motion to approve agenda as read Lovrine, second Bukovic. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Minutes from July read. Motion to approve Bukovic, second Lovrine. Vote all aye. Motion carried. Financial report was read. No questions. The Sconic Net contract was discussed and determined that it needs an engineer's analysis to be done, paid for by Sconic Net. Clerk reported that the owners who rent the Northern Lure have been sent a letter informing them of the need to submit a rental agreement and payments for the 1st and 2nd quarters of this year. Informed the board of an upcoming WTA seminar in September and that she was going along with Jane. Lastly, asked if the markings on the parking lot could be redone as they are fading, that the doors to the office, museum and fire department could be painted and signs put on them and a sign installed above the main entrance to the town hall. Tauer reported that the asphalt is done. They did have an incident with a belligerent citizen and the sheriff was called and the person was talked to by them. He did call the City of Crandon about the parking lot markings and they have not gotten back to him yet. He was also in contact again with Charles Man about doing the privy by the playground. He stated that he will get the job done between other jobs. Lastly, the one ton truck is at Sprenger Carrs Repair. Bukovic called Palubicki Electric about installing cameras at Station B and to redo electric at the trap range. He also said that the stop sign on Sucker Creek Rd has been moved. Bill should look at it. Lovrine stated that there are a lot of complaints on the potholes on Fournier Rd. Mark Ferris gave the clerk a check for \$1,000.00 for the digital sign. **CITIZENS INPUT:** Tom Carlstedt reported that the tower at Station B should be erected next week Will be getting costs for replacing building at the south end of Kentuck Lake and would like to build a freestanding .
